DID YOU KNOW?

ACCORDING TO THE NATIONAL FIRE PROTECTION ASSOCIATION, 70 PERCENT OF FIREFIGHTERS IN THE UNITED STATES ARE VOLUNTEERS.

In 2022, home fires are burning hotter, faster and more deadly than ever. This shift has required firefighters to increase their knowledge and skills through education and technological innovation. These changes have happened under the backdrop of volunteerism in the fire service decreasing over 20% over the past 30 years, adding strain to volunteer fire departments around the country.

Against this backdrop, the **Warren Volunteer Fire Department** has been very lucky to maintain a healthy and dynamic membership. With both deep experience, with our longest serving member at 56 years, as well as many young members, many of whom having taken the Vermont Fire Academy Firefighter I training certification, the Warren Vol. Fire Department is well situated to protect and serve the town of Warren, VT.

HOW WE SERVE

- 24 active members
- 80 internal training hours/year
- Additional trainings at the Vermont Regional and National Fire Academies
- Maintain 2 stations (Warren Village and Sugarbush) and 7 trucks
- 7 Officers who devote many hours a year for leadership
- Calls number from 80 to 100 a year and include:
 - fire alarms
 - carbon monoxide alarms
 - motor vehicle crashes
 - hazmat incidents
 - weather events
 - downed power lines
 - public service
 - structure fires
- Warren Fire Department is a member of the Capitol Fire mutual aid system
- Community Outreach: Fire Prevention for adults and kids, emergency responder parades during pandemic, fire extinguisher training for Warren businesses
